General Professional Recognition Learning and Skills (GPRLS) is a rolling scheme, funded by the Department for Innovation, Universities and Skills (DIUS).

All applicants must have registered with the Institute for Learning (IfL) prior to completing their application. Registration with IfL online is free, and their website address can be found overleaf.

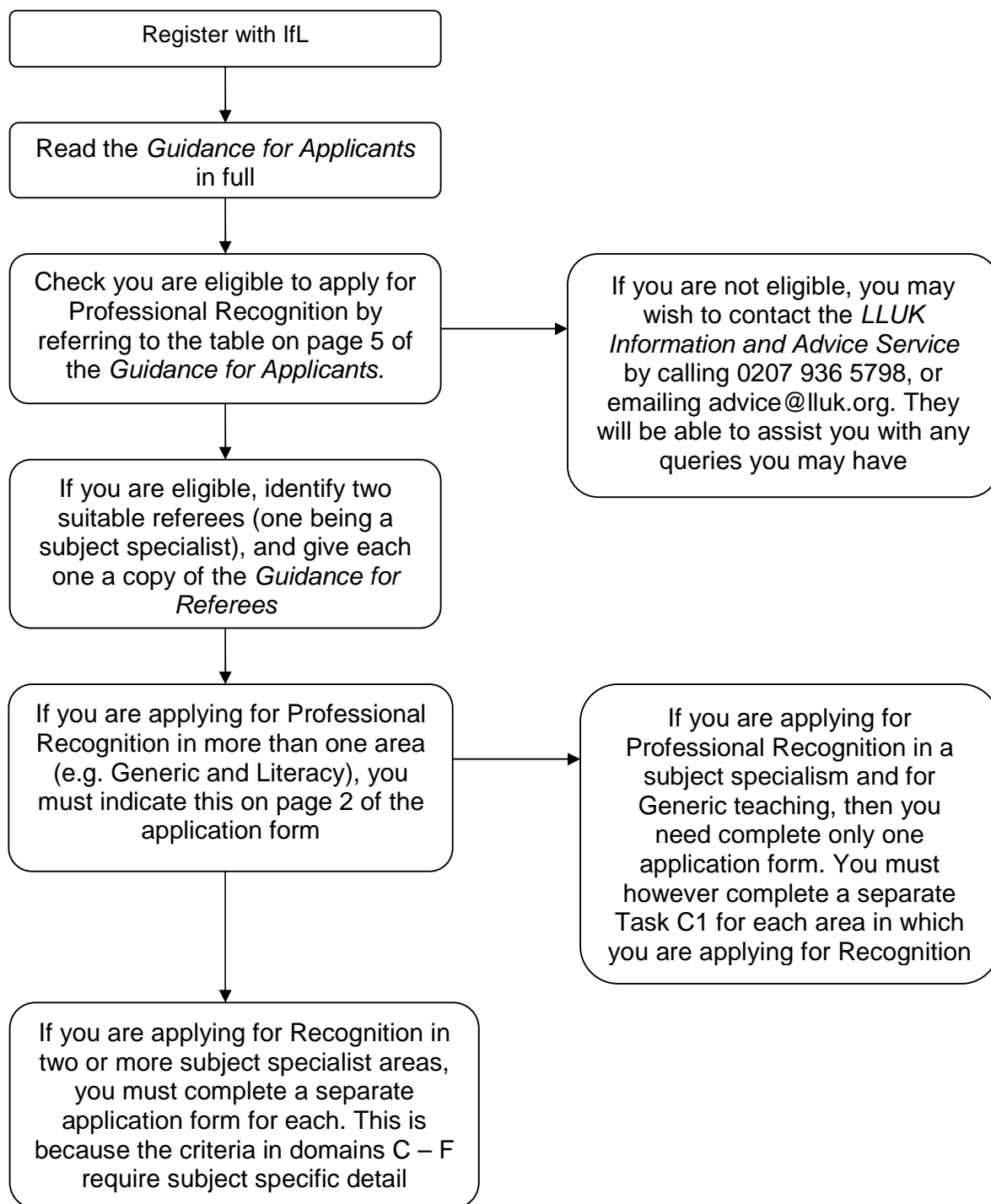

Signed and dated page 4 of the application form?	
Kept a hard copy for your own records?
