

## TARIFF OF LEGACY QUALIFICATIONS (TLQ)

The Tariff establishes how legacy qualifications in Initial Teacher Tutor Trainer Education map to the new *Equipping our Teachers for the Future* requirements in England.

The new *Equipping our Teachers for the Future* qualifications (PTLLS, CTLLS and DTLLS) contain elements that have been introduced over time and may not be covered in the legacy qualification e.g. introduction of the minimum core, emphasis on subject specialism, personalised learning. In these instances awarding institutions or other relevant bodies may require additionality in order to meet the full requirements of the qualification.

Legacy qualifications will only be mapped to an equivalent level in the new qualifications framework. e.g. NQF Level 4 FE Teachers Qualification will only be mapped to the same level qualifications in the new framework (PTLLS, CTLLS and DTLLS)

Legacy qualifications at Level 4 are based on the old National Qualifications Framework (NQF) levels. Level 4 in the new NQF has been broken down into three levels: Level 4,5 and 6. The new framework of qualifications is based on the new NQF.
